



Announcement: Moody's Ratings announces Polk County, IA's delayed sale of GO Bonds, Series 2025C and 2025D has no credit impact; par amounts changed

New York, October 02, 2025 -- Moody's Ratings (Moody's) notes that the delay in issuance of Polk County, IA's General Obligation Bonds, Series 2025C and Taxable General Obligation Bonds, Series 2025D has no credit implications. The proposed par amounts were updated as follows: \$6.9 million from \$9.7 million for Series 2025C and \$14.3 million from \$3.6 million for Series 2025D.

This update has no rating impact. We initially released these ratings on May 13, 2025 (see press release here: https://www.moody's.com/research/PR_909112804). The sales were then delayed, and the county is now looking to move forward. The ratings and the rationales for those ratings as stated in the original press release are still in effect.
